## Grading Policy

Grades are calculated according to the following formulae.

Full year course with a final exam.
For a full credit course of study where a final exam is given, the final grade will be determined according to the following breakdown:

First quarter = 20\%
Second quarter = 20\%
Mid term exam = 10\%
Third quarter = 20\%
Fourth quarter = $20 \%$
Final exam = 10\%
Thus, the mid term and final exam together will count for $20 \%$ of a student's final average. Each quarter, in effect, will count for $20 \%$ of the final grade to total $80 \%$ of the final average.

Full year course without a final exam.
For a full credit course of study where a final exam is not given, the final grade will be determined according to the following breakdown:

First quarter = 25\%
Second quarter = $25 \%$
Third quarter = $25 \%$
Fourth quarter = $25 \%$

Half year course with a final exam
For half credit courses of study where a final exam is given, the final grade will be determined according to the following breakdown:

First quarter = 40\%
Second quarter = 40\%
Final exam = $20 \%$

Half year course without a final exam
For half credit courses of study where a final exam is not given, the final grade will be determine according to the following breakdown:

First quarter = 50\%
Second quarter = 50\%
